Custom Built Raised Garden Beds

Fox Hollow Farm of South Huntington, NY, can provide custom built, wooden raised beds designed to suit your budget and site topography. Raised beds can be built in assorted sizes and heights offering gardenening ease for diverse gardeners including children, adults, or those with special needs.

Raised garden beds offer a contained way to provide quality soil in an easy-to-care-for space for vegetable crops. The beds should be situated with access to water and have sunlight for at least 8 hours per day.

Beds can be constructed from a variety of woods including: pressure treated wood (ACQ arsenic free, alkaline, copper, quaternary) or specialty woods such as red cedar, white cedar, or black locust. Choice of material would affect pricing.

Installation services include site evaluation, bed construction, and soil/compost/mulch delivery. Construction time to allow for the installation of 2-4 beds is two days.

Vegetable garden planning and ongoing agricultural mentoring services are also available.

Costs Estimates to Build and Install Beds

Final costs varies by the number of beds needed, specific size of the beds, type of wood chosen, and construction site logistics.

Construction materials, soil, and labor for building each raised bed of 4' - 5' x 16' - 20' x 1' is approximately \$800 in the Huntington New York area (*using basic ACQ pressure treated wood and a high quality compost/soil mix*)

Site preparation costs to receive the beds varies, is **site specific**, and can include fees for site evaluation and testing; planning and creation of construction documents; ground preparation and grading; municipal or community meetings; and in-kind contribution and volunteer coordination.
